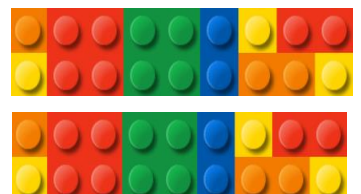

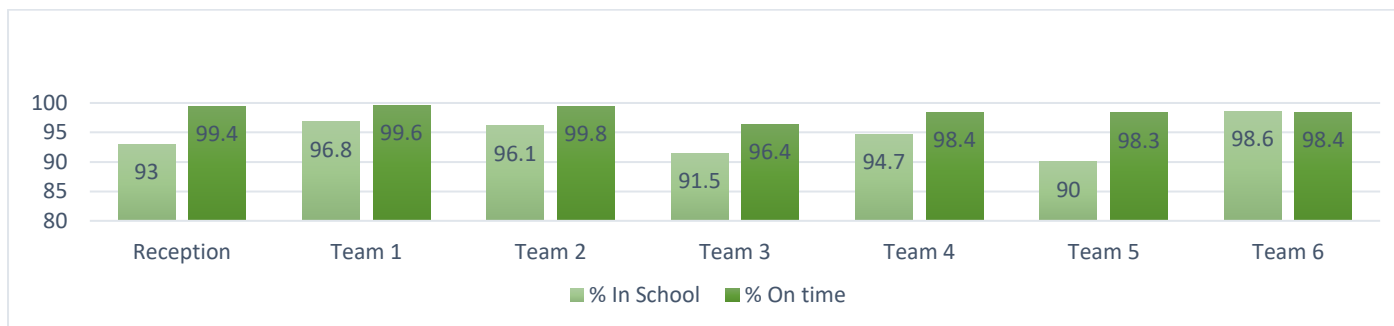
The junior children have learnt a new word recently...the word is
