Safeguarding Update - TRAFFIC and PARKING

I will be including a regular Safeguarding Update in each newsletter going forwards, and this month I want to mention traffic safety. As you are all very aware, the school being placed at the end of a cul-de-sac does not help with vehicles. All staff cars do not fit in the car park, so some need to park on the road outside. This limits the spaces in Denbigh Close, so this should be avoided

if possible please. The footprints on the pathway into school are there to discourage children from walking across the car park, as vehicles are coming in and out during the peak times when children arrive. Please ensure you set a good example by walking along the pathway yourself. Also, if the gates are closed when you leave, please close them behind you when you exit. Finally, the entrance at the back of school supports a considerable decrease in the number of vehicles in Denbigh Close – please use this entrance if you can, but ideally, avoid parking there – this was designed as a 'Drop and Drive' idea to keep the traffic moving. **N.B. This entrance is not staffed after 8.40am when registers close, so children will not be supervised into school if they are dropped off late.**




