

General Election...SCHOOL OPEN

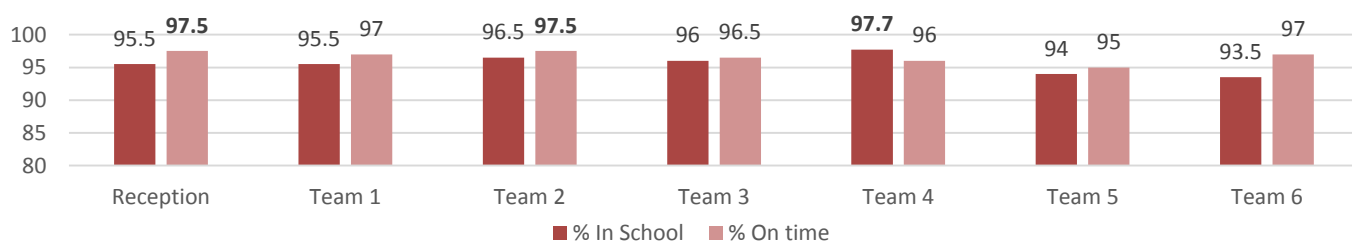
