Trainers...

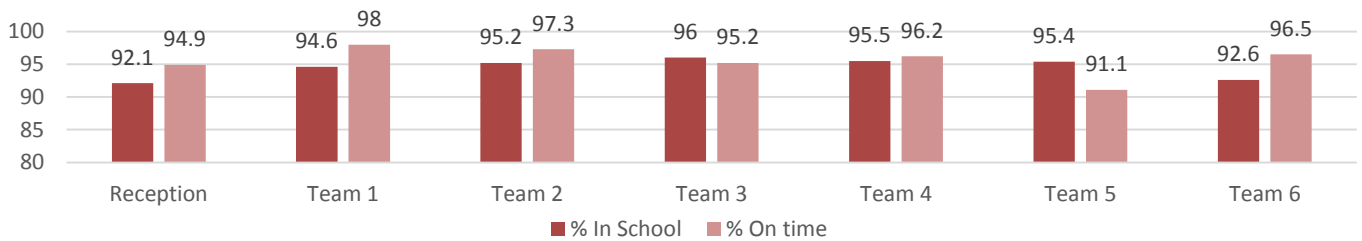


Please can I remind you again that trainers worn to school MUST be black. If children are wearing any other colour going forwards, then parents will be contacted by class teachers.
