

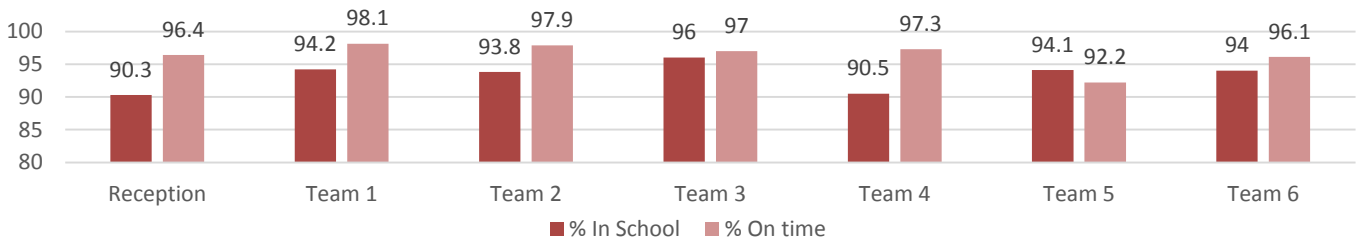
Online snack money...
