


Handwriting at Horn's Mill

Handwriting is discretely taught across the school from Reception, once children are ready. Children will progress from learning correct pencil grip and letter formation to cursive and then joined.

Guidelines for progression are below, but teachers assess once children have secured each step and are ready to progress onto the next part.



Reception/Team 1 - Basic letter formation using Ready Steady Read phrases

- Ee Ff Gg Hh Ii
- Jj Kk Ll Mm
- Nr Oo Pp Qq
- Rr Ss Tt Uu Vv
- Ww Xx Yy Zz

<u> Team 3 - 6 Joined</u>
